

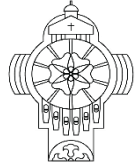

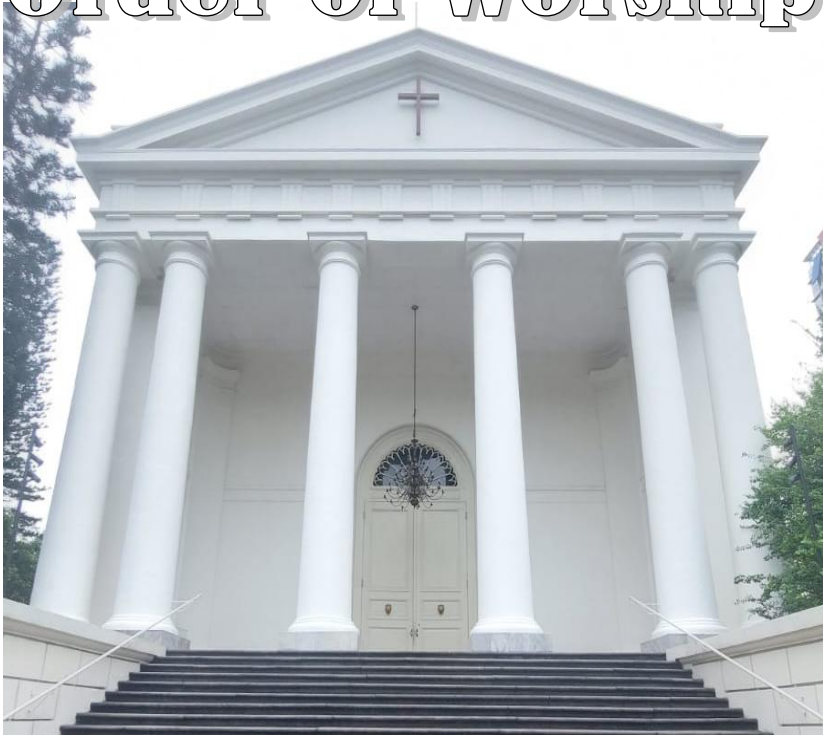

<sup>30</sup> In the same way the chief priests and the teachers of the law mocked him among themselves. "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself!

<sup>31</sup> Let this Messiah, this king of Israel, come down now from the cross, that we may see and believe." Those crucified with him also heaped insults on him.

**Sermon**

## **The Word Of Institution**

**Rev.** On the night before he was nailed to the merciless cross, Jesus shared His last meal with His friends. He took the bread, He broke it, and He gave thanks, and then He passed it among them saying, **This is my body which is broken for you. Eat it and remember Me.**

He took the wine, and He gave thanks, and then He passed it among them saying, **This is my blood which is shed for you. Drink it and remember Me.**

And so, we take, we eat and drink, and we remember: There is no greater love than this sacrifice which You, Jesus, made for us;

**Congr.** **When we come to this meal, O Lord, we are reminded that it is the death and darkness in us, that drove You to the cross; And so we come with no pride, no sense of entitlement; we come humbly and with deep gratitude; For it is You alone that has made a place for us at Your table. Amen.**

## **Epiclesis**

**Rev.** As you awaken us to your presence by your Spirit, may we know this bread and wine, to be your body and blood; As you embrace us now, by your Spirit, may we be changed, so that together we become the embodiment of your love, of your life to the world.

Drink, remember, and believe  
that the precious blood of our Lord Jesus Christ  
was shed for the complete forgiveness of all our sins.

**Rev.** Brothers and sisters who have received the bread and wine of the Sacrament of Holy Communion, may we always be strengthened and enabled to be witnesses of God.

**--- After completion, pastor invites Sidi Congregation who have received the sacrament of Communion to leave the table guided by the presbyter on duty with the instrument ----**
