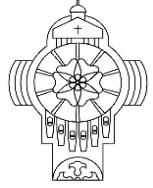

Eld. 3 The Scripture reading is taken from **TITUS 1:5-16 (NIV)**,
⁵ The reason I left you in Crete was that you might put in order what was left unfinished and appoint elders in every town, as I directed you.

⁶ An elder must be blameless, faithful to his wife, a man whose children believe and are not open to the charge of being wild and disobedient.

⁷ Since an overseer manages God's household, he must be blameless—not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to drunkenness, not violent, not pursuing dishonest gain.

⁸ Rather, he must be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined.

⁹ He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught, so that he can encourage others by sound doctrine and refute those who oppose it.

¹⁰ For there are many rebellious people, full of meaningless talk and deception, especially those of the circumcision group.

¹¹ They must be silenced, because they are disrupting whole households by teaching things they ought not to teach—and that for the sake of dishonest gain.

¹² One of Crete's own prophets has said it: "Cretans are always liars, evil brutes, lazy gluttons."

¹³ This saying is true. Therefore rebuke them sharply, so that they will be sound in the faith

¹⁴ and will pay no attention to Jewish myths or to the merely human commands of those who reject the truth

¹⁵ To the pure, all things are pure, but to those who are corrupted and do not believe, nothing is pure. In fact, both their minds and consciences are corrupted.
